Presentation categories

Proposals can be submitted for either 50 minute or 20-minute presentations:

- 50 minute presentations: 40 minutes presenting & 10 minutes for questions
 - *Research Report*: One or more presenters share their original research on a relevant topic.
 - *Awareness Session*: One or more presenters address the audience on relevant topic. Content should provide specific implementation ideas.
 - *Workshop Session*: One or more presenters conduct a hands-on workshop to allow participants to experience implementation. Workshop should allow time for participants to debrief and provide feedback.
- 20 minute presentations: 15 minutes presenting & 5 minutes for questions
 - *Hot Topic Session*: It is a brief oral summary of an innovative or successful teaching experience or research related to the CLIL classroom. These sessions should be succinct & to the point. Presenters are not expected to implement any activity with the audience.

Proposals may be:

- Report results of original empirical research.
- Reflect or offer critical commentary on topics in the field based on (limited) research, classroom-based experience, and/or theoretical considerations.

How to submit your proposal

Submit your proposal to info@clilsymposium.co and ppoole@uninorte.edu.co. An e-mail acknowledging receipt will be sent to you within 2 days of submission. (Please check your spam filter if the e-mail notification does not reach you).

Format of abstracts

All submissions must include an abstract of 150-250 words, excluding the title, names and affiliations. Do not include charts, tables, images, or bibliographical references in the abstract. You should provide 3 or 4 keywords too that will also help us place your abstract into the appropriate category, as well as not more than 100 words of biographical data. Before submitting your abstract, it is advisable to check the number of words and for typing errors using a word processor. Please make sure that you do not use your name or refer to your home institution in the abstract itself, otherwise your proposal will be automatically rejected. These details should be provided in the Biography section of the submission form.
