Presentation categories

Proposals can be submitted for either 50 minute or 20-minute presentations:

- **50 minute presentations:** 40 minutes presenting & 10 minutes for questions
 - *Research Report:* One or more presenters share their original research on a relevant topic.
 - *Awareness Session:* One or more presenters address the audience on relevant topic. Content should provide specific implementation ideas.
 - *Workshop Session:* One or more presenters conduct a hands-on workshop to allow participants to experience implementation. Workshop should allow time for participants to debrief and provide feedback.
- **20 minute presentations:** 15 minutes presenting & 5 minutes for questions
 - *Hot Topic Session:* A brief oral summary of an innovative or successful teaching experience or research related to the CLIL classroom. These sessions should be succinct & to the point. Presenters are not expected to implement any activity with the audience.

How to submit your proposal

Submit your proposal to clilsymposiumcolombia@gmail.com. An e-mail acknowledging receipt will be sent to you within 2 days of submission. Please check your spam filter if the e-mail notification does not reach you.

Format of abstracts

All submissions must include an abstract of 150-250 words, excluding the title, names and affiliations. Do not include charts, tables, images, or bibliographical references in the abstract. You must also provide 3 or 4 keywords to help place your proposal in the appropriate category, as well as not more than 100 words of biographical data for each presenter. Before submitting your abstract, check the number of words and for typing errors using a word processor. Please ensure that you do not use your name or refer to your home institution in the abstract itself, otherwise your proposal will be automatically rejected. These details should be provided in the Biography section of the submission form.
